# BEAUTY SCHOOL: hair donut how-to

The easy way to master a big ballerina bun...

You're probably wondering just what the heck a hair donut is. Turns out it's not sugary or deep-fried (sorry, guys) – but it is pretty freaking amazing. It's basically a round, donut-shaped piece of foam or mesh that helps you get the biggest, chicest bun of your life with minimal effort. Sound great? That's coz it is. Not to overtype it, but this awesome, slightly weird-looking hair tool might just change your life.

To prep for the look, wash and towel-dry your hair. While hair is still damp, pop a small amount of smoothing serum through the mid-lengths and ends, then blow-dry. The smoothing serum will help ensure your bun looks glossy and polished, and it'll also help keep those pesky flyaways at bay.

**1** Pull your hair into a high ponytail, securing tightly with an elastic band. Now slip the hair donut over your ponytail and move it all the way down to the base so that it's sitting on your head.

**2** With the donut on, pull small sections of your ponytail over the donut and pin them right near the base of the donut, so that each little section of hair covers up part of the donut. Keep moving around the donut gradually, pinning as you go, until the entire donut is covered by hair.

**3** Now for the finishing touch... Take the leftover strands of hair that are poking out from the bun, wrap them around the donut and secure them with bobby pins. Complete the look with red lipstick and winged eyeliner. Black Swan, eat your heart out!
