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THE PIN-UP

Get the look 1 Blow-dry while combing hair with fingers. "Your hands are the key tools for this look," says Danilo.

2 Leaving out the top layer of your hair, back-comb sections at the crown with a fine-toothed comb. Then do what Danilo calls French lace: more teasing, but with a brush. "It creates a light and fluffy fullness."

3 Using your fingers, rake hair to the centre of your head (like you're making a ponytail), twist up, and insert several bobby pins to secure.

4 Smooth the unteased part over the up-do with a brush; artfully pin hair into place. "Use the tail end of the comb to help push hair in."

5 A mist of lightweight hairspray will hold the style and add shine.
