"Blow-dry hair and apply a leave-in treatment or heat protector," recommends hairstylist extraordinaire and all-round awesome guy Barney Martin (barneymartin.com.au).

"Next, tie hair into a ponytail on the crown of the head. Pull it through a hair donut and lightly backcomb with a soft brush. Smooth hair over the donut and pin [with bobby pins]. Finally, spray with hairspray to hold in place."

PEEK-A-BOO CURLS

Frame your face with a soft curtain of waves. Here are Barney's top tips for getting perfect curls at home: "Start by blow-drying hair smooth to create your base and reduce the risk of frizz. Next, take medium sections (around two inches wide) and curl sections using a large curling iron, then coil the curl back up and pin to cool. Once the hair's cold, lightly brush it out and finish with a gloss serum to add shine."
