symmetry equals beauty in the human eye. So doing your brows, no matter what face-shape you're blessed with, is the single most powerful thing you can do to be your most beautiful you.

SO MANY OF US OVERDID OUR BROWS BACK IN THE DAY, AND NOW THEY'RE SPARSE AND HAVE GAPS. YOU RECOMMEND WE SORT THAT OUT BY ...

Right! Remember when super, over-tweezed brows were in? So many of us lost our brows during that phase because they can stop growing back in. If you have gaps in your brow the best thing to do is use a pencil that looks like real hair. If you have a few patches it's okay – just make sure you find an amazing product that looks like real hair to fill them in.

WHAT'S THE NUMBER ONE MISTAKE WE MAKE WITH OUR EYEBROWS?

The number one mistake is not doing them. Not doing your brows robs your face of symmetry and being its most beautiful. The next biggest mistake is using a product that doesn't look natural.

WHAT'S THE ONE THING YOU WISH WE'D ALL DO INSTEAD?

Take a few minutes and really learn the right way to do your brows. Once you do it's empowering and fun!

TELL US WHAT YOUR FAVOURITE BROW TRICK IS?

Knowing where to start, arch and end your brow is the most powerful brow trick you

can ever learn. The easiest way to do this is by lining up your brow pencil vertically along the side of your nostril and up to the inner corner of your eye. The place where it passes through your brow is the exact spot your brow should start. To find your perfect arch, lay your brow pencil at the side of your nose. Let the mid-section of your pencil line up with the outside corner of your iris. That's where your arch should hit. I think the most important is the last one: line the pencil with the side of your nose and go to the outside corner of your eye. Your brow should always end there. Need more tips? PENCIL, MASCARA-STYLE BRUSH OR A LITTLE WAX?

I favour a pencil because you can really get the look of real hair. You have to have great brows already to just use a gel or a wax alone. A brow pencil that looks like real hair, adheres to skin and lasts all day is worth its weight in gold!

THE TATTOO TOUCH

Brow tattooing has come a long way in recent years with a hot new technique that creates 100 per cent natural looking brows. The technique sees a brow specialist make deep "scratches" in the brow which are then filled with permanent dye, giving the impression of real hair.

The treatment can transform sparse or barely-there brows into perfectly symmetrical arches that frame the face just so.

"This technique looks completely natural because it mimics real hair," says Australia's brow queen, Amy-Jean Linnehan. "Brows can be subtly coloured or completely remodelled because each new strand is intricately etched and coloured by hand."

We gave it a whirl and found the scratches hurt, even with anaesthetic cream. On a scale of one to 10, however, they're about a four. That is, bearable.

Immediately after tattooing, brows look strong and a little shiny but they calm down by the next day. By the second session (you'll need two) they look full, strong and gorgeous. Do we like? We definitely do. To learn more visit amyjean.com.au

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
